## Eligibility: Camp Goodtimes

Our camp doors are open and welcome to children/young people who fit the following edibility criteria:

- Campers are between the ages of 8–17 at the time of camp
- Are personally dealing with a pediatric cancer diagnosis in their family
- Are one of the following:
  - A patient currently on treatment for cancer
  - A survivor who is currently off treatment
  - A sibling to a patient or survivor
  - A bereaved sibling to a family whose child passed away from cancer or a complication from their cancer treatment
- Have a physician's OK to attend camp if they are currently on treatment
- Meet the minimum medical criteria
- Are approved by the camp director and medical lead (we have reviewed your completed application and we believe that we can safely care for the health and well-being of your child) AND we have an available space for their age and gender

### Please note:

- **Siblings**—in order to serve as many families as possible, our policy is to register ONE sibling per patient/survivor. Any additional siblings that have an interest in attending camp should register as a WAITLIST SIBLING on the application. IF, once the application deadline has passed, there is room to accept multiple siblings, your family will be notified.
- **Two campers per family**—if you're a bereaved family OR if the patient/survivor is either too young or too old to attend Camp Goodtimes or simply has no interest in attending, you can submit applications for two siblings from the same family. Any additional siblings can apply as a WAITLIST SIBLING on the application, and if room remains available after applications close your family will be notified.

*Acceptance to Camp Goodtimes is at the camp director's discretion. Applications do not automatically mean acceptance to camp. We reserve the right to cancel registrations as needed.*
